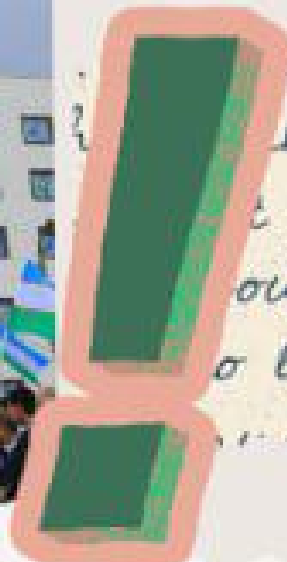

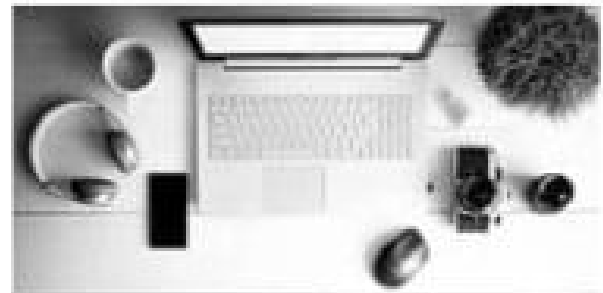

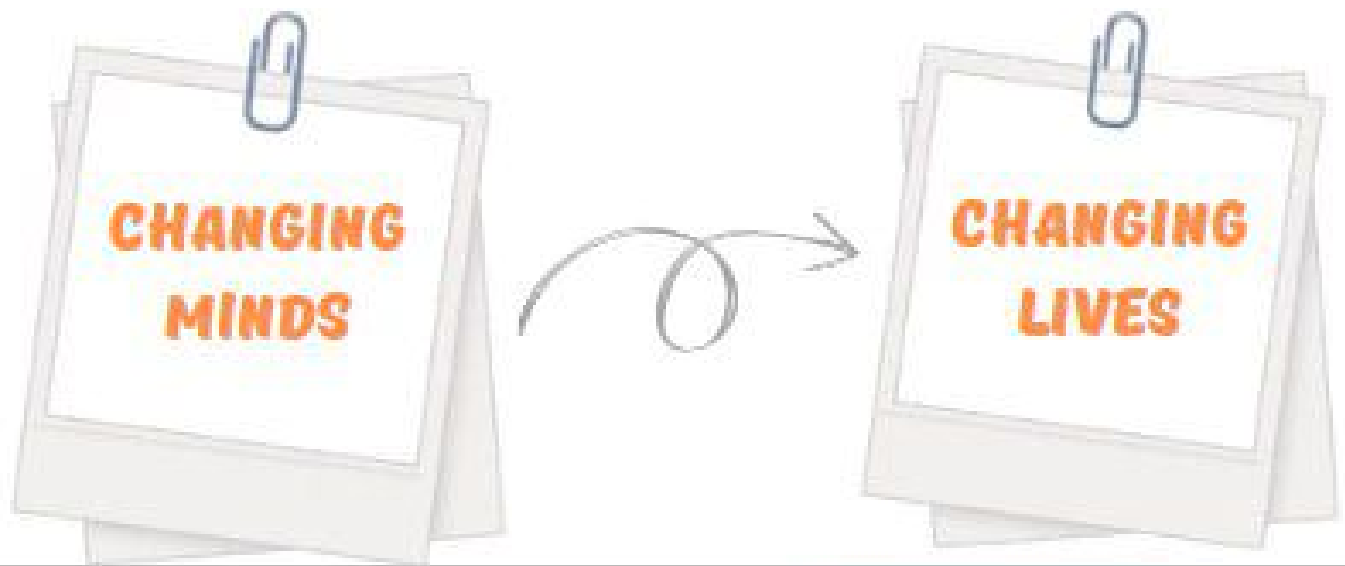


How important internet today?

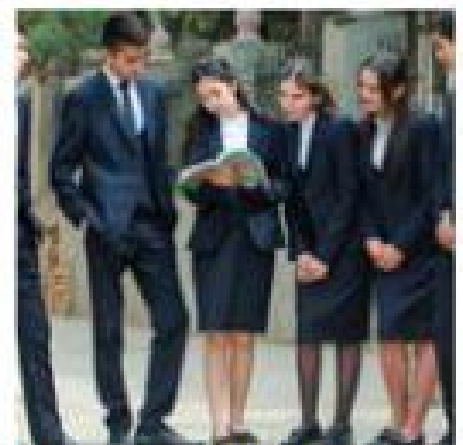

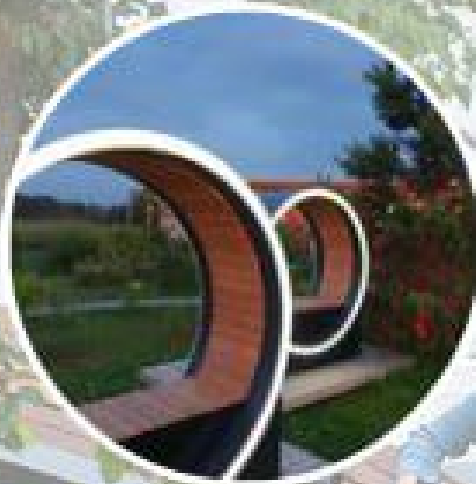

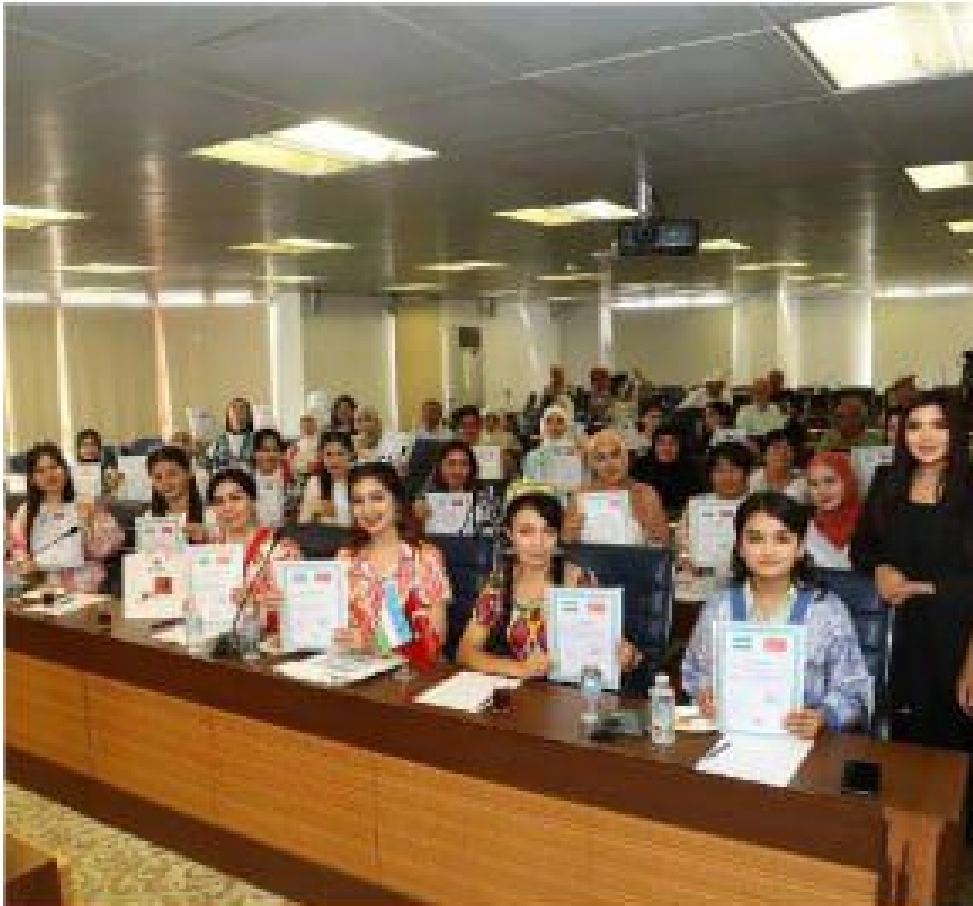
Despite the recent opening of the NamSIFL University, the number of students applying here is increasing every year. Just like there are two sides of every things, there is a positive and negative side of this idea.
